## How to get from the airport to the city centre:

- Shuttle Bus (Navette): The Lianes 1+ airport shuttle bus departs from the airport's bus station (Navette Aéroport) and makes several stops in the city.

The journey takes approximately 45 minutes and tickets can be purchased from the driver or at the airport. The price may vary, but it's usually around  $\in 8$ .

## How to get to the Stade de Bordeaux:

**- Tram:** Take Line C towards "Parc des Expositions" or "Bassens - Carbon-Blanc" and get off at the "Parc des Expositions" station, which is located right by the stadium.

- Bus: Several bus lines head to this area, including lines 15, 25, and 73.
