

- **Traboules:** Lyon is famous for its traboules, secret passages that crisscross through buildings and courtyards. Exploring these hidden passages is a unique way to discover the city's history and architecture.

How to get from the airport to the city centre:

- Rhônexpress: This tram-train is the fastest and most convenient way to travel to the city centre. The journey takes about 30 minutes, the service is frequent and tickets can be purchased online, at the airport, or on the tram itself.

How to get to the OL Stadium:

- **Tram:** Take the T3 tram line towards "Meyzieu Les Panettes" and get off at the "Décines Grand Large" station, which is located right by the stadium.
- Bus: There are bus options (lines C9 and 85) that can take you to the stadium area.
- Rhônexpress: The Rhônexpress is an express tram-train service that connects the city centre with Lyon-Saint Exupéry Airport. Hop on at Part-Dieu station or other stops in the city to the airport and, from there, take a shuttle bus to the stadium.
