How to get from the airport to the city centre:

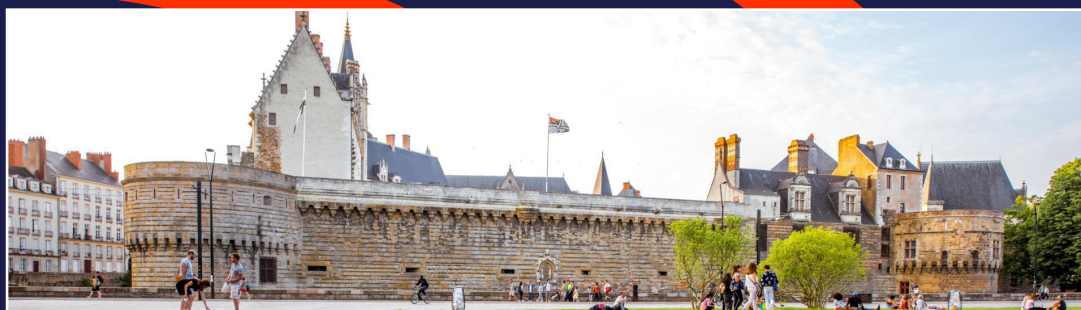
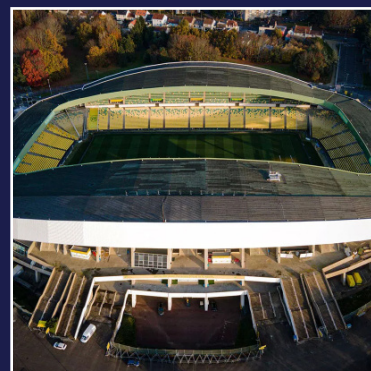
- Shuttle Bus: The Navette TAN Air bus departs from the airport and takes approximately 20-30 minutes to the city centre. The ticket can be purchased on the bus. The fare is typically around €9 for a one-way ticket.

How to get to the Stade de la Beaujoire:

- Tram: Take Tram Line 1 towards "François Mitterrand" or "Beaujoire" and get off at the "Beaujoire" station, which is located right by the stadium.

- Bus: Several bus lines head to the area, including lines 50, 75, and 80.
